DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

The owner of any dog(s) **FIVE MONTHS OF AGE OR OLDER** shall annually on the **FIRST** day of **JANUARY** obtain a license from the Town Treasurer. **WRITTEN PROOF** of current rabies vaccination must be included with the application. Applications made after **JANUARY 31** of each year shall be delinquent and a **\$5.00 late fee** set by State Statute shall be charged. An additional **\$5.00 fee** will be charged after **April 1**. **Owners of unlicensed dogs are subject to a \$150.00 fine.**

ORDINANCE #1991-11-21

ESTABLISHING DOG LICENSE FEES

The Town Board of the Town of Washington does ordain as follows:

Ordinance #1989-11-2A is hereby repealed.

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 174.05(3) the Municipal Code of the Town of Washington is hereby amended to add the following section.

2.1-3.0265 License Fee: No person shall own or keep a dog over the age of five (5) months within the limits of the Town of Washington without first obtaining a license from the Town Treasurer or other authorized agent of the Town of Washington by application. The license fee shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) for each spayed or neutered dog and twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each un-spayed or un-neutered dog. The fee for a kennel license shall be fifty-five dollars (\$55.00). A late fee in accordance with State Statutes shall be applied per dog after January 31 of each year. Exemptions to the license fee shall be granted in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes 174.054 or 174.055 (\$150.00 forfeiture).

The effective date of this ordinance is January 1, 1992.
